## **QUITO & GUAYAQUIL AIRPORT**

• Free shuttle service in connection with GO cruises. Pick up time from hotels to airport: approx. 3 hours before the flight, from/to specific hotels in Quito and Guayaquil. Reservation is required.



- Quito: Go Quito Hotel, Patio Andaluz, Mama Cuchara, Mercure, Marriott, Swissotel, Dann Carlton.
- Guayaquil: Palace, Grand Hotel, Wyndham, Oro Verde, Hilton Colon.

Pick-up items will be reconfirm at the hotel the night before the departure.


